The Scientific Committee welcomes the submission of abstracts for oral / poster presentations. Please adhere strictly to the following guidelines to ensure your submission is processed successfully.

General Information

Word Limit: The abstract text is limited to 150-250 words excluding the title, author's names, and affiliations.

Presenter Requirements:

The abstract main author must be a registered participant. Abstract submission does not automatically register the presenting author.

File Upload Requirement: The abstract to be submitted in word format. Font : Times New Roman, Font size: 12 with line spacing of 1.5, as final formatting will be performed later for inclusion in the conference proceedings.

Notification of Decision: Presenting authors will be informed regarding acceptance or rejection and mode of presentation (oral or poster) of their abstract after the review process.

Specific Information

Title: The title should be clear, concise, and accurately convey the study's focus. Only the first word should have capital letters.

Authors and Affiliations

List all authors in the order of their contribution. Provide the institutional affiliation of each author viz., Department / University / Company / Country. Include the email address of the presenting author. Indicate the presenting author using bold and underlined text. Abstracts should cover Objective, Methods, Results and Conclusion.

Travel and Accommodation

The organizing committee suggests the delegates to make their own travel arrangements from the airports (Hyderabad/ Nanded) to Udgir to avoid inconvenience. Delegates will be picked up from Udgir Railway station / Bus Stand to the venue of conference. Accommodation will be available at the Resort. In case of non-availability accommodation at the resort, delegates may also be accommodated at hotels in the city. Registration fee, to and fro Travelling and Accommodation expenses have to be born by the delegates / invitees attending the conference.

Dr. J. P. Dubey / IAAVP Young Scientist Award

Applications are invited from the life members of IAAVP with a minimum qualification of M.V.Sc. degree in Veterinary Parasitology and not above the age of 35 years as on 31.12.2025 for Dr. J. P. Participants are requested to send a soft copy of full length paper with an abstract (300 words) based on their original research carried out in M.V.Sc./ Ph.D.in the format of Journal of Veterinary Parasitology to Dr. C. Sreekumar, Editor-In-Chief, Journal of Veterinary Parasitology, e-mail: editorinchiefjvp@gmail.com so as to reach on or before 15th October, 2025. Scanned copies of necessary documents like proof of age, educational qualifications and IAAVP membership should be sent with the manuscript. An undertaking about the publication status of the abstract in the prescribed format should also be sent.
